



## NSBTR Privacy Statement

NSBTR is committed to protecting your personal information and this statement will outline how we use the information you provide to us in order to further our work in helping our dogs.

### Your information and why we need it

NSBTR collects information from its supporters for different purposes that are outlined below:

#### For adoption purposes

When you register to foster or adopt a dog from NSBTR we obtain information relevant to this application such as your name, address, contact number and details about your home environment that is relevant to the potential dog that you wish to adopt. We do this to ensure that both you and the dog have the best possible chance of a happy future together.

All our prospective adopters are required to have a home check prior to acceptance to foster or adopt one of our dogs. To enable this one of our approved home checker's will be provided with your contact details. You will be made aware of the home results by NSBTR and your details will be added to your application.

It is law that all dogs are microchipped and we need to ensure that all dogs leaving the care of NSBTR have been microchipped to their new owners. To do this we obtain information relevant to this purpose.

#### Fundraising

If you engage with our fundraising events we will obtain your contact details and we may require payment details.

### How long do we retain your information?

NSBTR Adopter – these are supporters who have rehomed a dog from NSBTR and therefore we believe that you would like to remain in contact with us and have access to support from us throughout the lifetime of that dog.

To allow this to happen we will keep your contact details for 20 years.

Homecheck - Should you be unsuccessful or decide you do not wish to pursue your application you can ask for your details to be removed at this stage. If you continue on with your application the above NSBTR Adopter applies.

Fundraising - these are supporters who give donations, enjoy our auctions and partake in our fundraising events throughout the years. As these supporters are also adopters then the above applies.

### Making changes to your data

We like to ensure that we always have up to date contact information to ensure the ongoing support of our dogs and rely on you to help us with that.
